What impact does your donation make?

Just 6 months of rental assistance can be all it takes for a family to begin having control over their own housing stability. In Kent County, it costs over \$3,000 to house a family of four in emergency shelter. It costs only \$3,500 to assist a family of four with scaled rental assistance in the Congregational Partnership Program.

What is the need for rental assistance?

Each family in the Congregational Partnership Program receives 6 months of rental assistance on a graded scale. The rental assistance provided decreases each month. This allows a family to gradually pay more of their rent each month. Any donated amount is greatly appreciated and can be a part of a family re-entering stable housing.

How can a congregation raise funds?

Congregations can donate from a benevolence fund, take a collection from congregation members, or host a “1 Day to End Homelessness” event. The CPP can provide presentations to raise awareness of homelessness and resources to aid in raising funds.
